Our defence was always tight, with both Zac and Luke (in particular) making numerous outstanding plays.

The hitting was again led by Luke (BA .490), who would then always put pressure on the defense with his base stealing. Kane's on base average of .600+ due to a strong batting average, and good plate discipline leading to many, many walks. This provided lots of scoring opportunities. The number of K2s was reduced. Throughout the season, Zac only struck out twice, while Kane only struck out 3 times.

But to come back and win consistently to win the competition, there were timely hits throughout the lineup (especially during the final series).

Because we were always under pressure in the second half of the competition, some of the guys got less playing time than we would have liked, but were important for the success of the team, so the support from Oliver and Cameron was much appreciated.

Once in the finals, the team approached each game with confidence. We expected to win each game, but still had to do it. Our pitching again provided the platform, with contributions from all the team - good defence, getting on base followed by hits with runners on.
