Purpose

The Manly Eagles Baseball Club (MEBC) is committed to fostering an environment of respect, professionalism, and high performance both on and off the field. As a senior player, you represent the club, the community, and the sport of baseball. This Code of Conduct outlines the standards expected of all senior players.

1. Commitment to the Club
