Women's baseball is going through a thrilling phase of expansion, not just at the grassroots but at the elite level. 2026 will see the inaugural season of the Women's Professional Baseball League. Nine Australian players have been drafted to the 4 American based teams, creating a viable option for women to develop and get paid to play the sport they love. Our women's baseball program at Manly Eagles is also in an exciting period of growth. 2025-26 continued under the careful guidance of David Gledhill and Stuart Air, bringing their expertise and passion to every training and game. Following in Sarah Burnes and Sienna Gledhill's footsteps from 2024-25, we saw two more juniors progress into our women's ranks. Darci Madden and Olivia Cunningham immediately became integral players, playing a range of positions, and bringing a fantastic energy and growth mindset to the team. These are exciting times, as a big goal of the Manly Eagles women's committee has been to sure up the gap between junior girls and Manly Eagles.

Baseball NSW continued to create opportunities for girls to play baseball, introducing a second division of the Gaynor Cup, U/15. With two divisions, girls can now progress through the age groups with their peers, gaining greater experience and more opportunities. Cailtin Air, Madison Mumford, and Tashana Mottram were involved with the coaching of the Manly Juniors U/15 Gaynor Cup team. Their work as role models and to help juniors see what is possible, while providing quality coaching and training will allow women's baseball to progress in leaps and bounds on the Northern Beaches.

We had some big milestones this season for some of our senior players. Helen Wyatt became only the 3rd woman to reach 50 games for Manly Eagles. This represents a huge commitment over 5 seasons. Helen has given so much to the club and baseball through her work in minor league. Isobel Demol also became the most capped women's player, surpassing our previous holder in the final game of the season. We would like to recognise her commitment over 7 seasons, which included our inaugural season in 2014-15. Congratulations Helen and Izzy! We are so proud to have you as part of our club.

The Manly team also participated in the inaugural BNSW Pink Round which was held at BISP. The atmosphere was fantastic, with all clubs and divisions in one place for the first time. This was an exciting event which provided opportunities for players to interact with current NSW and Emerald players. It was a resounding success and BNSW intends to continue the experience over the coming seasons.

1st Grade Report 2025-2026

After a long hiatus, it was great to be back coaching at Manly this year. Not knowing exactly what to expect, I was really pleased with the players' commitment to training and the effort they consistently displayed.

Games 1 and 2 against Blacktown gave me an early insight into the character of this team. Although we lost both, the players never gave up, which became a defining feature of how we competed throughout the entire season. Our results and overall record did not truly reflect the capability or effort of the first grade squad.

At times, we made things difficult for ourselves early in the season, with too many free 90's and walks, along with conceding one big innings in games. Combined with an inability to execute in key moments, this led to a number of narrow losses, often by only a few runs.

Improving our execution across all areas of the game and becoming more consistent in the critical "1%" moments will be key to climbing the ladder next season and improving our win-loss record.

There were many highlight-reel plays throughout the year, along with clutch hitting, key strikeouts, and plenty of banter. This group made the season both enjoyable and, at times, challenging to coach.

Player Highlights

Aidan Torpey was the workhorse of the team. His competitiveness and strong desire to win saw him throw a large number of weekend games. His 160+ pitch performance against Baulkham Hills was outstanding. He also led the league in foul balls over the first base dugout, while hitting over .300 for the season.

Shohei carried much of the midweek pitching load and consistently competed, keeping us in games, while working closely with many of our young pitchers to help them improve.

Hisato, Max, and Jack all contributed on the mound. A special mention to Hisato, who reinvented himself as a hitter—leading the team averages after Christmas—and produced many crucial hits and strong defensive plays.

The infield was primarily covered by Harley, Torpey, Simon, the Rae brothers, and Nick. There were numerous double plays and several highlight-reel defensive efforts. Tian had an excellent rookie season, particularly defensively, and finished with the highest batting average in the team.

The outfield was covered by Brown, Kingy, and Hayden, all of whom made valuable contributions. Hayden led the team in stolen bases and finished second in batting average.

Catching duties were handled by Parko, who did an excellent job behind the plate in his first year back, always working hard to refine his game and developing his understanding of opposition hitters.

Isaac, our import, made valuable contributions both on the mound and in the outfield (when not busy breaking sobriety and making roses).

Flewy, returning from injury, played a vital utility role, filling in across multiple positions and contributing some excellent hitting at the back end of the season.

I'd also like to acknowledge all the players who consistently filled the bench each week, both home and away. It was great to see us match most teams with our numbers and depth.

It was encouraging to see several emerging talents stepping up from the U16's and U18's for their first experience in the State League. Despite the less than ideal results, I hope these players view this season as a valuable first step with plenty of opportunities and success ahead.

The team faced a tough season, ending with 1 win & 17 losses. If we set aside a couple of blowout games, the group was competitive each week and just needed a few more hits to convert opportunities into runs. Across the season, the team scored 50 runs while conceding 139 which is not enough and too many. Many free passes led to extra opportunities for the opposition providing undeserved runs. Although opposing teams batted .263 against us which is a little high does not equate to the 139 runs conceded.

Every week there was the potential for the team to break out and score big. Unfortunately, it did not materialise, but that promise was always present which is a testament to the inherent talent across the team. Our solitary win came because of extra and consecutive hits scoring runs. We just need to do that more often.

We had a large squad with 39 players participating in some way across the season. I appreciate the support the club gave to ensure the team was complete and competitive week to week. As with every season, some players stood out for their performances.

Austin Holley pitched 43 innings, recording 58 strikeouts and an ERA of 7.61. Austin Holley was our go-to pitcher pitching week every week. There were some brilliant outings and significant growth for him from prior season who will continue to get better and better. Austin Murdoch delivered 17 innings with 14 strikeouts and an ERA of 6.88. Sean Chivers also contributed and had an ERA of 0.0 till his last game. Special mention goes to Hamish Mallum, who pitched 5.1 innings with an ERA of 0.0. It is regrettable that Hamish was not given more opportunities with the ball with those stats.

Leading the batting was Austin Murdoch, with 34 plate appearances resulting in 15 hits, a batting average of .484, and an on-base percentage of .529—an outstanding achievement for a rookie only 15 years old. I am a strong believer in OBP as a key indicator for scoring runs. Chris Hurley had 20 plate appearances, an average of .417, and an OBP of .650. Several players finished with averages in the .300s, including Owen Harris, Jake Wander, Kai Harris, and Ash Egan. Across the team we had so much potential with the bat but struggled to put it all together.

Fielding is an area needing improvement, with 52 errors from 462 total chances (11.25%), averaging three errors per game. Defensive work across 3rd grade must be strengthened. That being said, special mention goes to Ash Egan, Kai Harris, and Jack Kelly for their strong performances across the season.

Finally, many thanks to Helen & Simon Tibbett for their relentless support scoring games week to week. I'm a numbers person so every week I'm reviewing player results looking to see how I can

leverage the strengths and couldn't do that without them. Also, thanks to Matt Eisenhauer for the best ground in Sydney, Tim Clarke, Sean Chivers, Owen Harris, Glenn Murdoch for their coaching support, Viv & John in the canteen, Luke on the EBSN and to those on the State League committee headed up by Mike O'Neil ensuring that everything is in place so that we can play the game that we all enjoy so much.
